## This funding will be used to:

- increase the percentage of students achieving an 'A-C' standard or above in English to 75% across Years 1–6
- increase the percentage of Prep students who are able to read and comprehend text and compose and record short, meaningful sentences to 75% at the reporting level of 'Working With' or better.

## Our initiatives include:

- developing teaching capacity through implementing the Instructional Coaching Model (co-plan, co-teach, co-reflect, co-assess)
- embedding professional development to improve student performance by teaching the Instructional Coaching model for reading and comprehension and Levelled Literacy Intervention
- embedding short-term data conversations and monitoring to analyse data to inform best practice teaching in reading and writing
- refining the school pedagogical framework and use this as the shared language of teaching and learning
- providing education for parents of kindergarten students to support the development of oral language and early literacy and numeracy at home.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by:

Embedding the culture, climate, processes and protocols of classroom observation and feedback to support professional development and encourage reflective practice/action learning.	<b>\$ 4 182</b>
Developing and implementing a whole school approach to teaching reading and writing for teachers, teacher aides and parents based on evidence-based research.	<b>\$20 000</b>
Providing TRS to enable triads of teachers/leaders to engage in collaborative data inquiry, action learning, classroom visits and professional conversations.	<b>\$ 6 000</b>
